- supporting each other as brother priests, one-to-one or in small group meetings for PRAYER and FRATERNITY, retreats or seminars.

## SPIRITUAL ADOPTION

Members maybe SPIRITUALLY ADOPTED by religious sisters, in the same way as priests were adopted by St. Therese of Lisieux. Priests who are not members may also be adopted.

## MEMBERSHIP and ORGANIZATION

The Movement is a private association of diocesan priests approved by the Congregation of the Clergy. It is directed by its international coordinator, Fr. Pascual Cervera, assisted by the members of the council , and regional coordinators.
